**NOTE:** All fees, clubbed together, are to be paid quarterly (i.e. in April, July, October & January), in advance, by 15th of the first month of the quarter. Late fee fine of Rs. 200/- will be imposed, if the fees is not paid by 15th of the first month of a particular quarter. This fine will be applicable up to 15th of the next month. Additional fine of Rs. 200/- per month will be payable, if the fees of that particular quarter is paid in subsequent months of the quarter.

For example, the fees of April to June quarter, if not paid by 15th of April, will attract fine of Rs. 200/-. It will be applicable upto 15th May. After 15th May (i.e. on/after 16th May) the additional fine of Rs. 200/- (i.e. Rs. 400/- clubbing the fine of previous month) will be charged. Likewise, fine @Rs. 200/- per month will add up in subsequent months. If fees remains in arrears for one quarter, without any valid reason, the school reserves its right to strike off name of the student and issue TC.

If fees remains in arrears for two quarters, without any valid reason, the name of the student will be struck off & TC will be sent to the parents by post at their recorded address, under prior intimation.

## **CASHLESS TRANSACTION FACILITY:**

All the fees (Activity, Tuition & Bus) will have to be deposited online (i.e. through internet). The parents are requested to access the menu through <a href="https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect">https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect</a>. No other mode of depositing fees will be accepted.

In extreme cases, the fees can be deposited by Bank Draft in favour of the concerned school / in cash.

## **SCHOOL TRANSPORT:**

The school takes all care to provide safe and convenient transport to all the students. Our buses are equipped with all the facilities including GPRS system, first aid box, speed governor, CCTV cameras, fire extinguishers etc. Parents are requested to avail the transport facility provided by the school. The bus fare is very reasonable and the school incurs losses on bus operations. Even then keeping in view the safe convenience provided by the school, we have continued this facility.

**Note:** if you wish to avail bus facility in the middle of the session, kindly intimate the school authorities a month in advance. Please refer to the bus rules in the fee card for further information.

# **RULES FOR SCHOOL BUS USERS:**

- The bus fare shall be payable for all the months except May & June due to vacations, in advance, along with school fees. Full month's fees is payable even when the facility is availed for a single day in that month.
- The buses will pick up the students from allotted bus stops and drop them, after the school hours, at the same stop. The school does not take any responsibility for the child to reach home after he/she is dropped at the allotted bus stop.
- If the student discontinues the facility & wants to re-avail it after some time, during the same academic year, he/she will have to make payment for the gap period also.

- The details of the stoppages mentioned above are fixed ones. Buses do not ply according to individual convenience. If parents change their address after admission, the school will make changes in the bus routes or stoppages as per convenience of the school. It will not be a binding on the school to provide bus facility on change of address of the student.
- **Punctuality**: Please ensure that your child arrives at the designated bus stop on time to avoid delays in the bus schedule. Being punctual helps maintain the efficiency of the buses and ensures timely arrival at school.
- Respect for Bus Drivers and Helping Staff: Encourage your child to show respect and gratitude towards the bus drivers and helping staff. They play a vital role in ensuring the safety and comfort of the students during transportation.
- **Prohibited Behaviors**: Eating, drinking, shouting, throwing objects, bullying or engaging in any other disruptive behavior is not permitted in the bus. Such actions can endanger the safety of other students/staff due to distraction of the driver.

#### PRIVATE AND OWN TRANSPORT RULES:

The school does not take any responsibility for any incident that takes place in private transport. It is mandatory for students who come to school by their own conveyance to wear helmets and carry a valid licence, if they are permitted, as per RTO rules.
